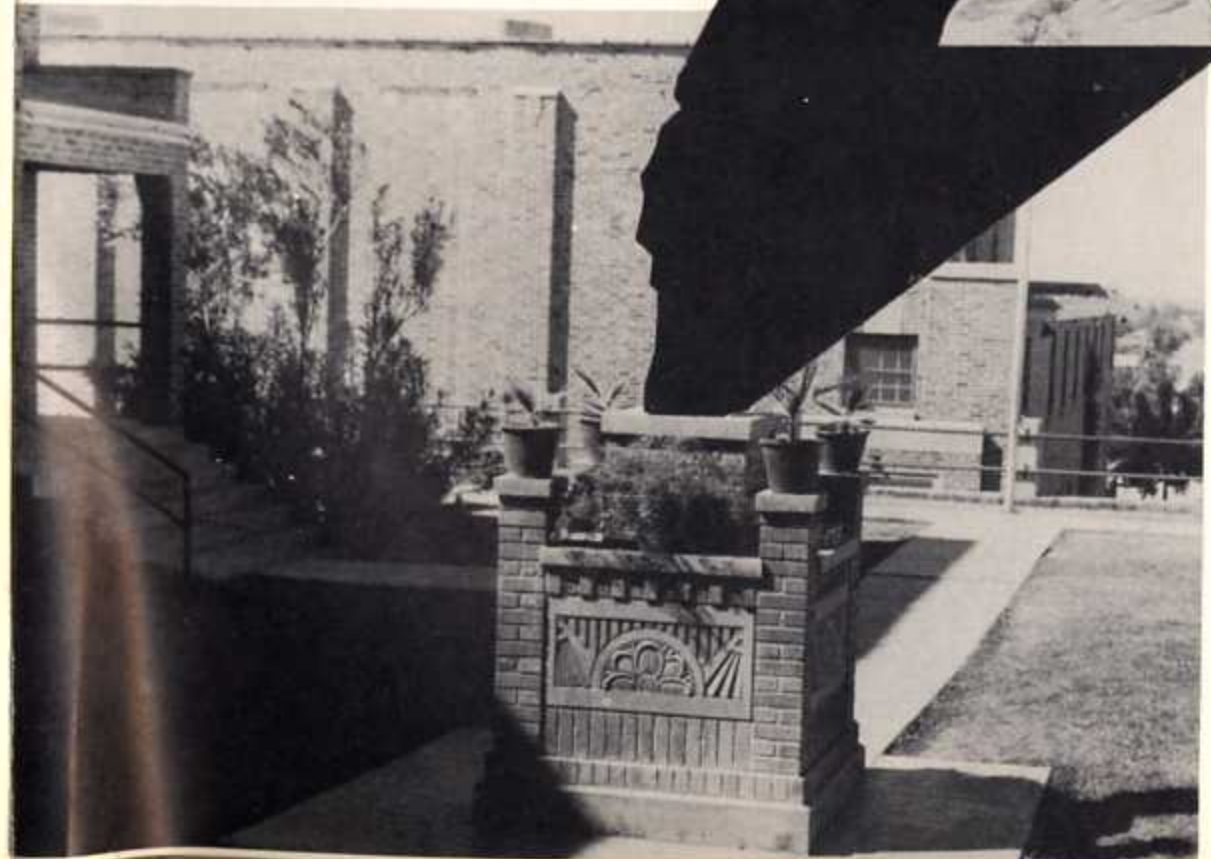

## OUR CITY

The City of Laredo, Texas, dates back to the year 1755, when Don Tomas Sanchez, an officer in the Royal Army of Spain, founded it. It grew as a fortified settlement on "El Camino Real," where commercial caravans going from San Antonio to Mexico converged.

At the close of the Mexican War, when the Rio Grande had been established as the International boundary between the United States and Mexico, this little village became of paramount importance as a port of entry. Laredo became the central distributing point for the territory and began the steady growth that has brought it to its present size and importance.

Leading industries in Laredo are cattle raising, farming, oil production, manufacturing, import-export and tourist trade. A large number of Laredo's 63,500 people are on federal payrolls due to its importance as a port of entry.

Laredo has churches of all denominations, public and private schools, and a Junior College.

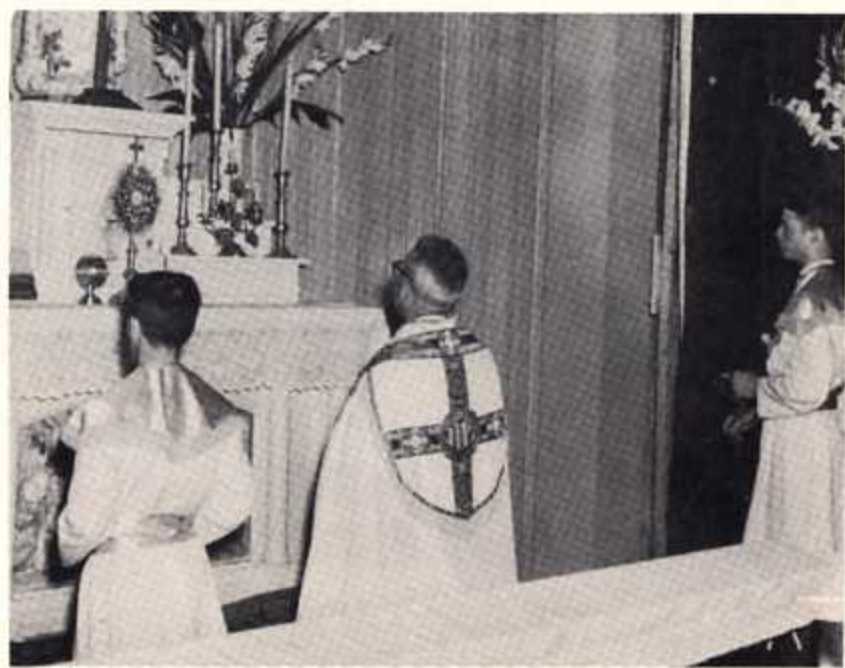

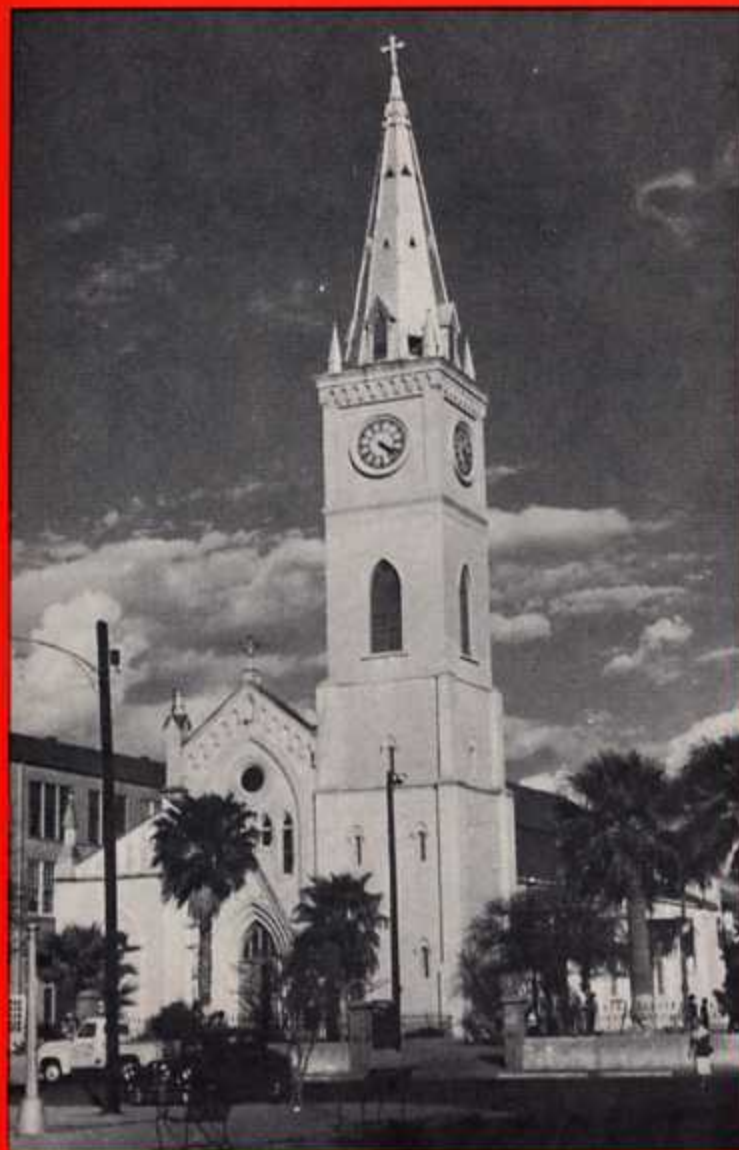

These men have dedicated their lives to God and His Blessed Mother, and in doing so, they have dedicated their lives to youth.

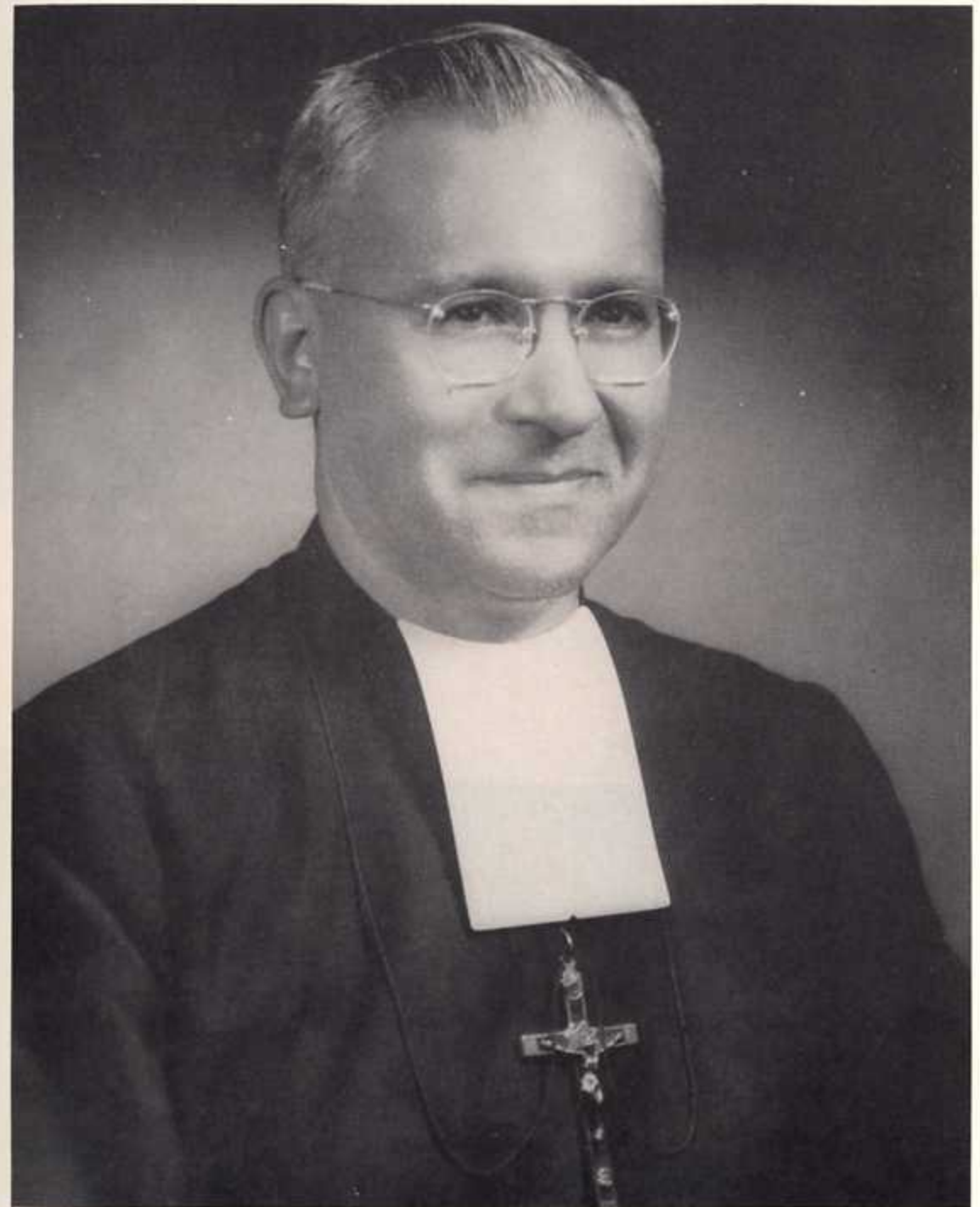

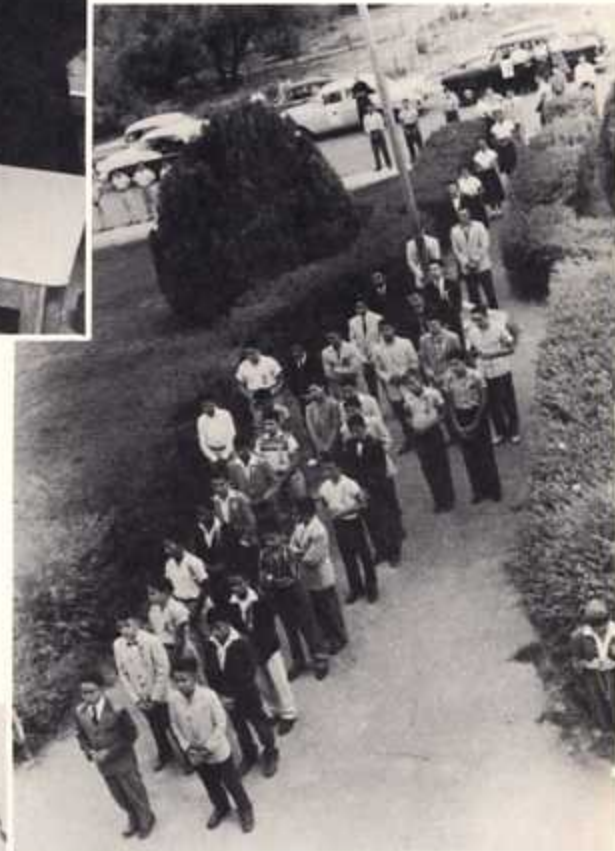

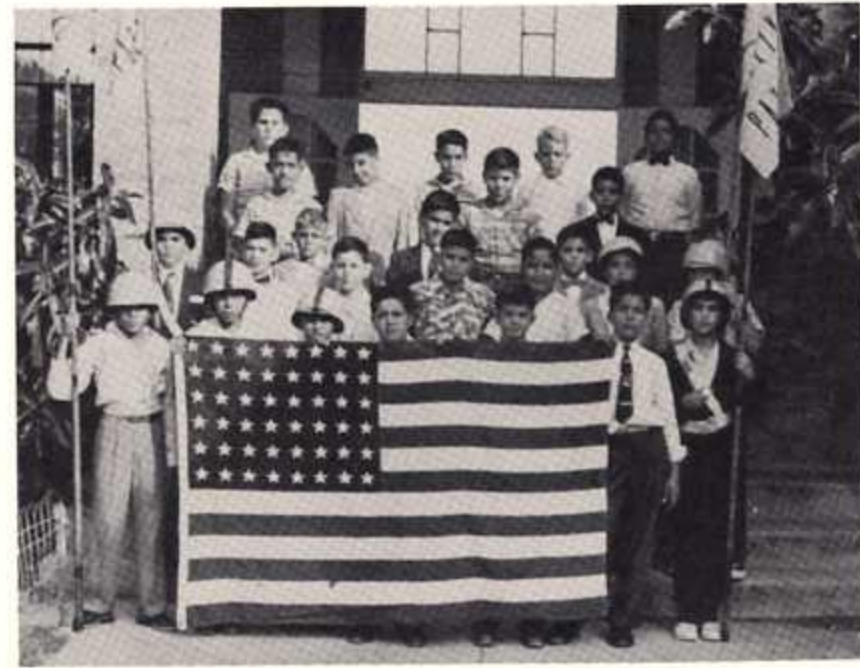

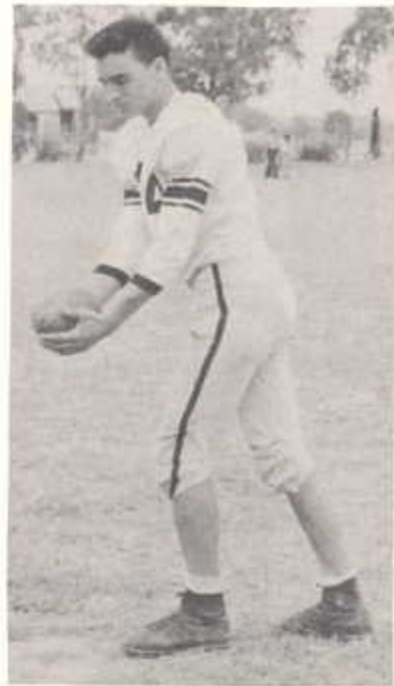

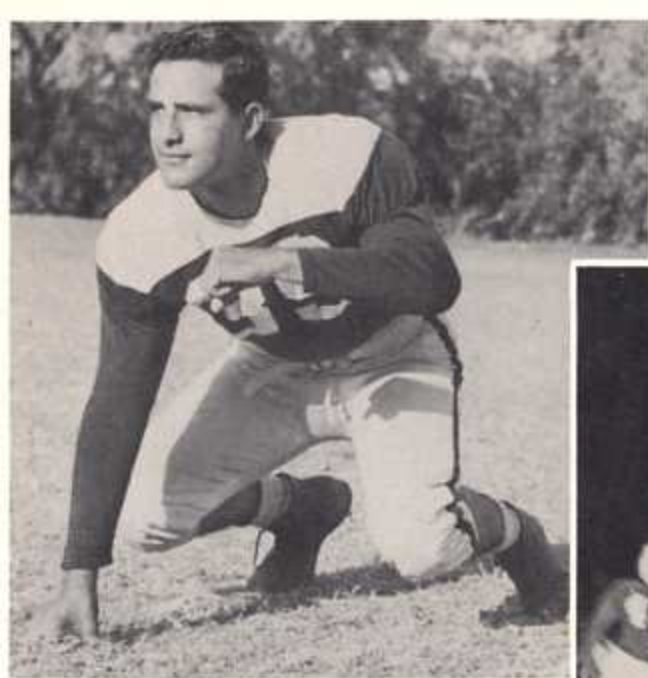

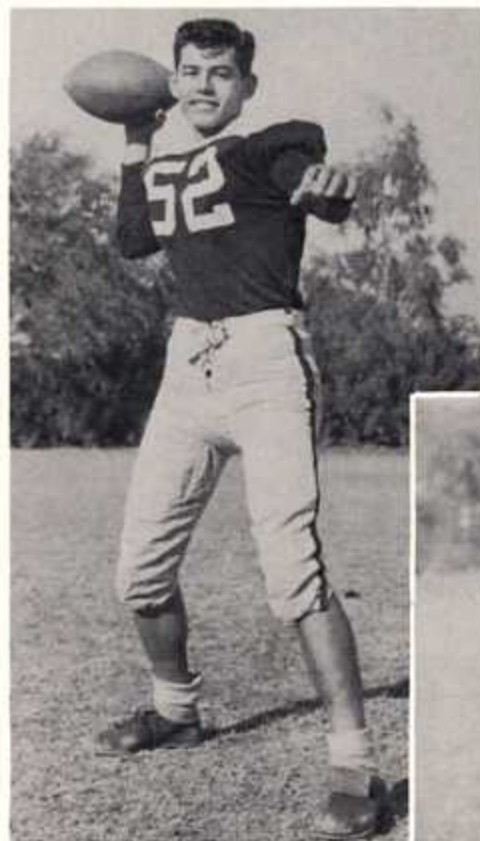
