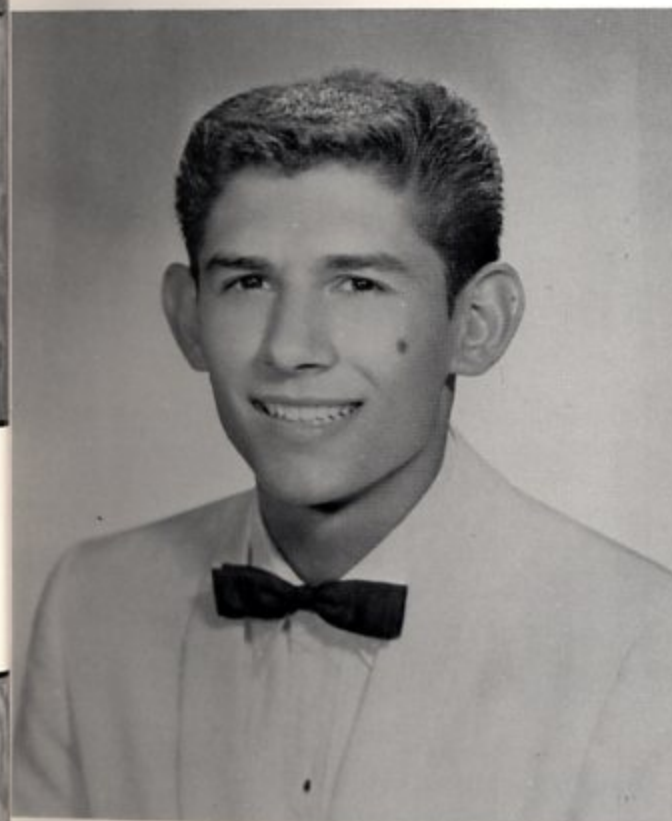
## MICHAEL AMICI

## SABAS ZAPATA III.

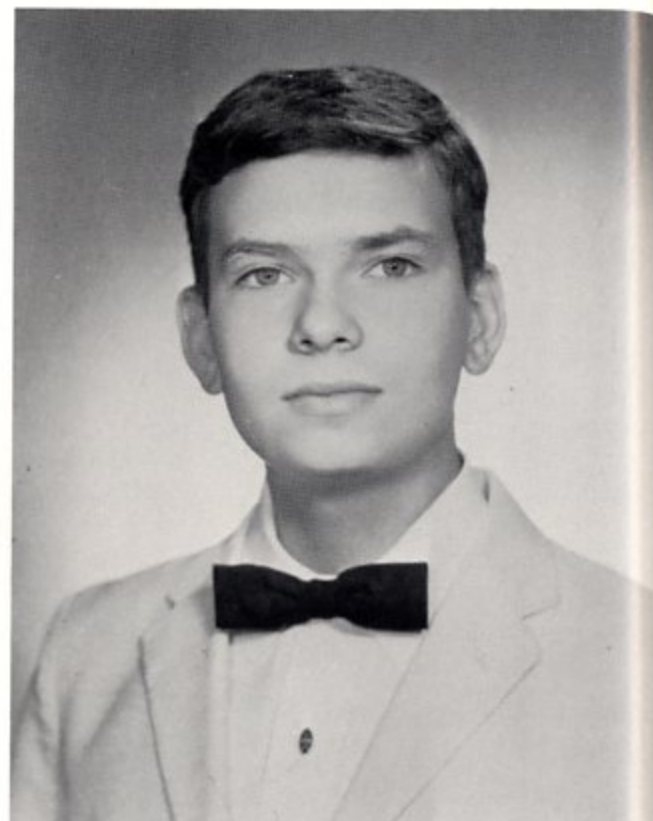

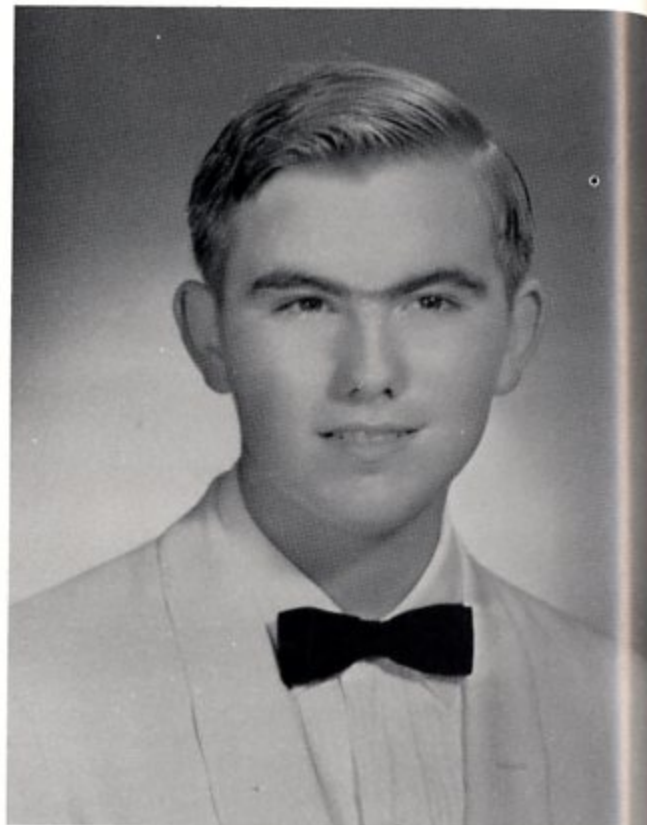
#### RODOLFO ARAIZA

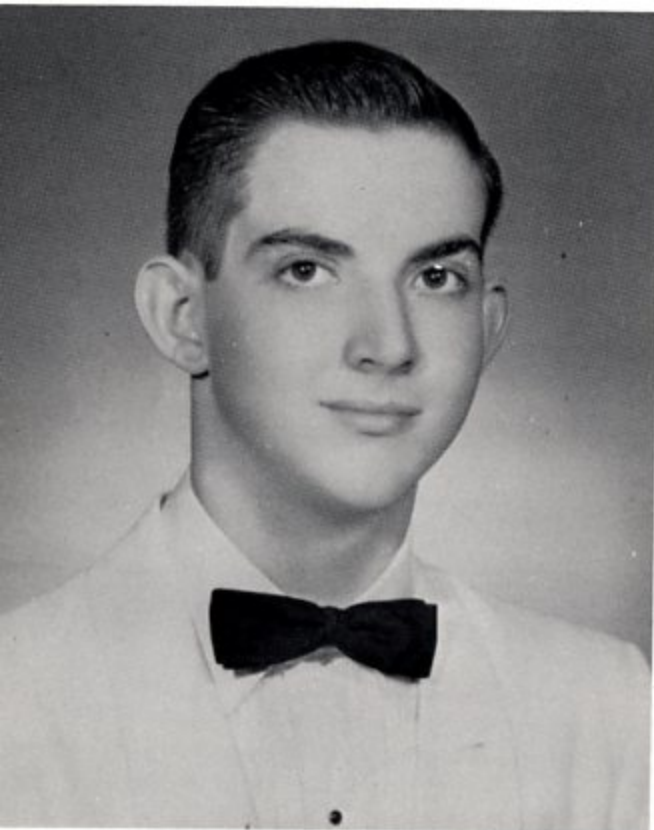
RICHARD F. CAMPBELL JR.

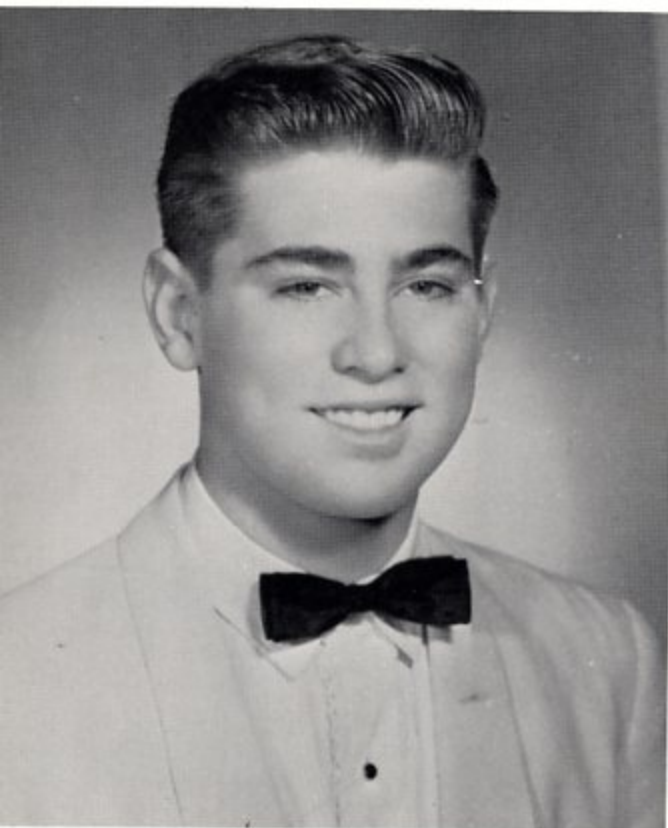
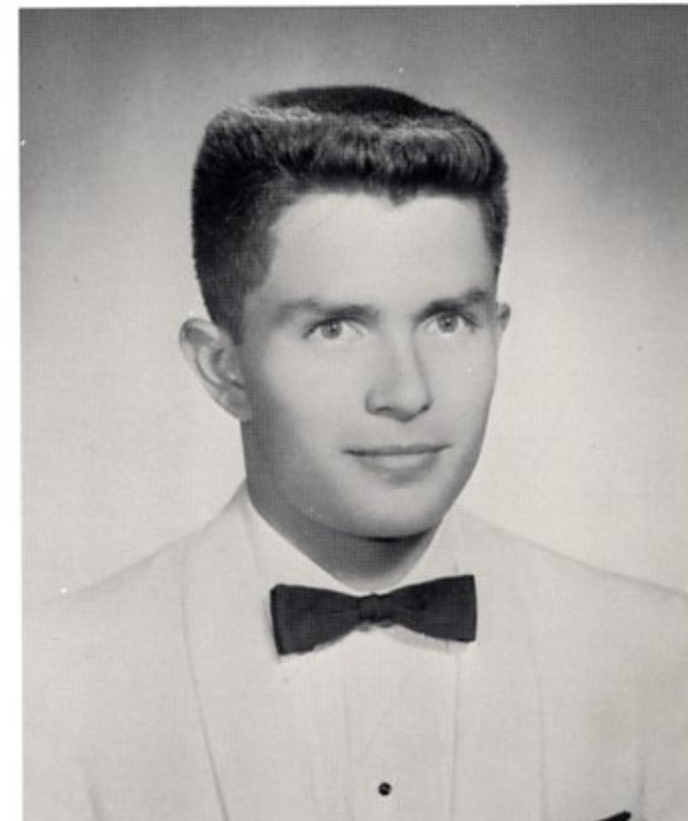
# FRANCIS DE LLANO

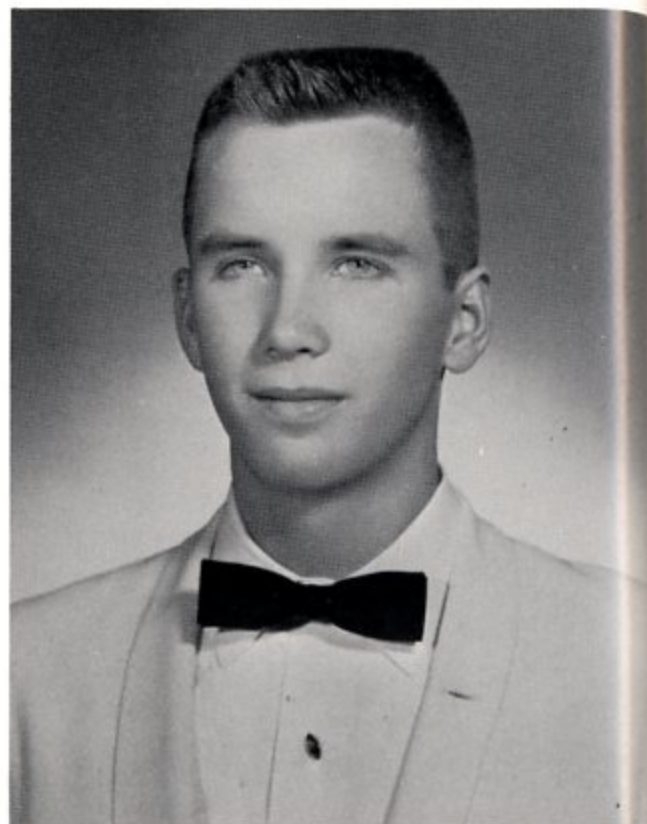
# VICTOR FLORES JR.

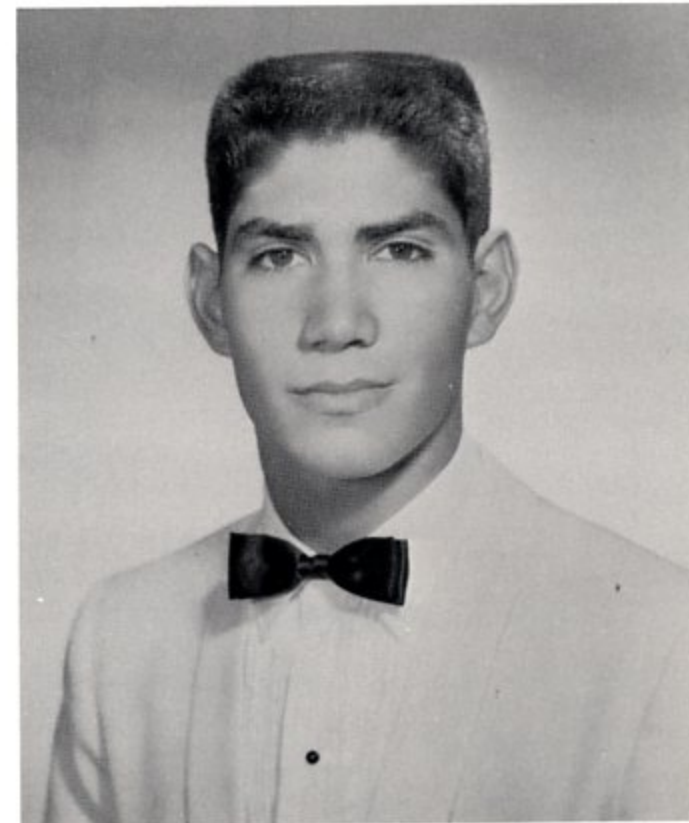
#### EDWARD FREEMAN

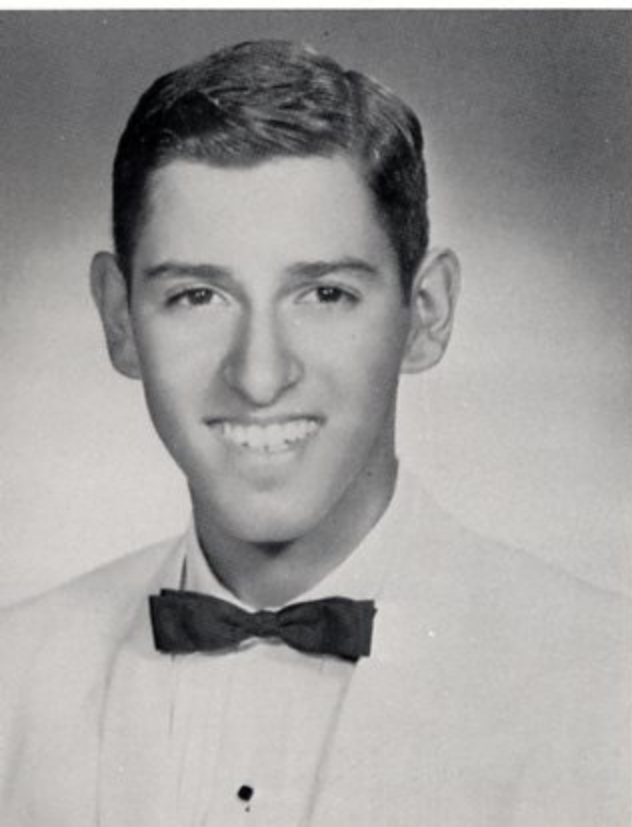
#### RAFAEL GARCIA, JR.

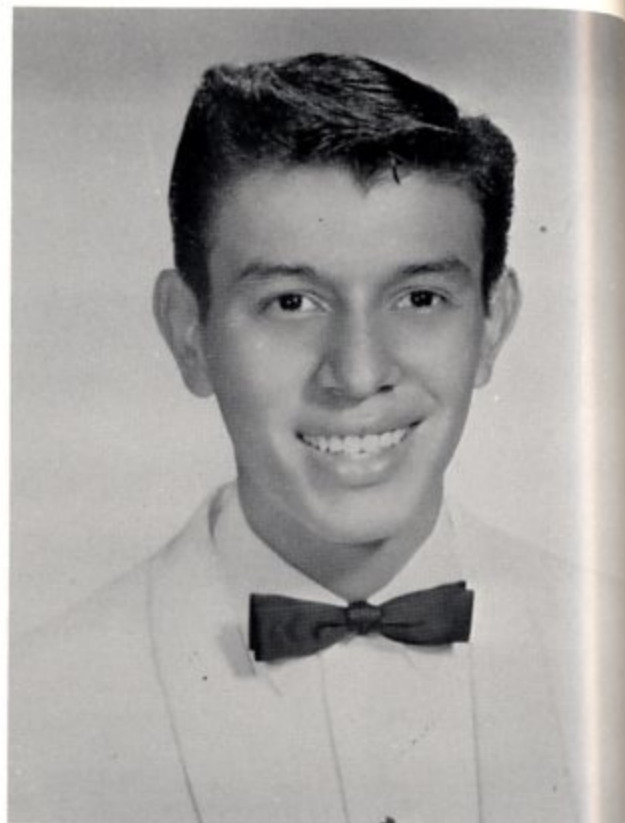
#### MARIO GONZALEZ DAVIS

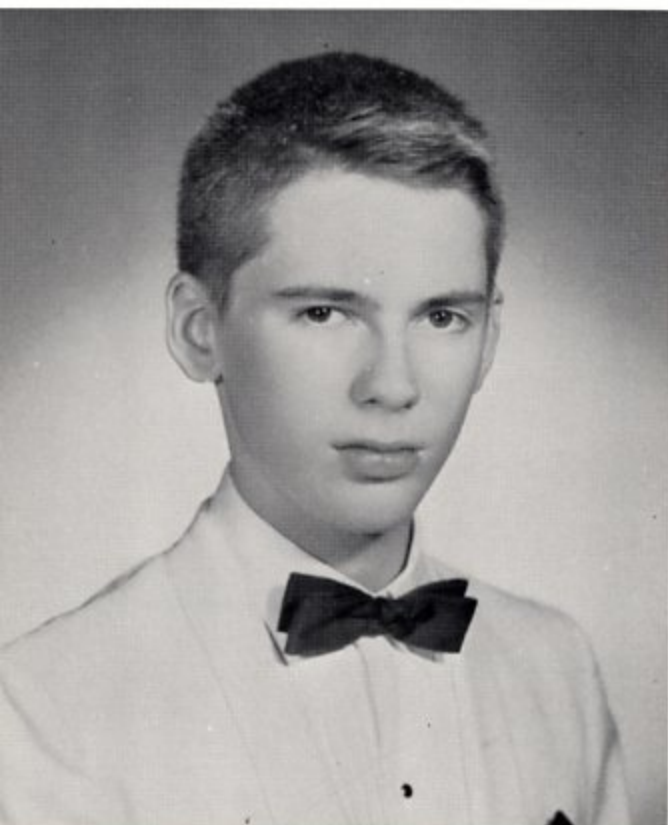
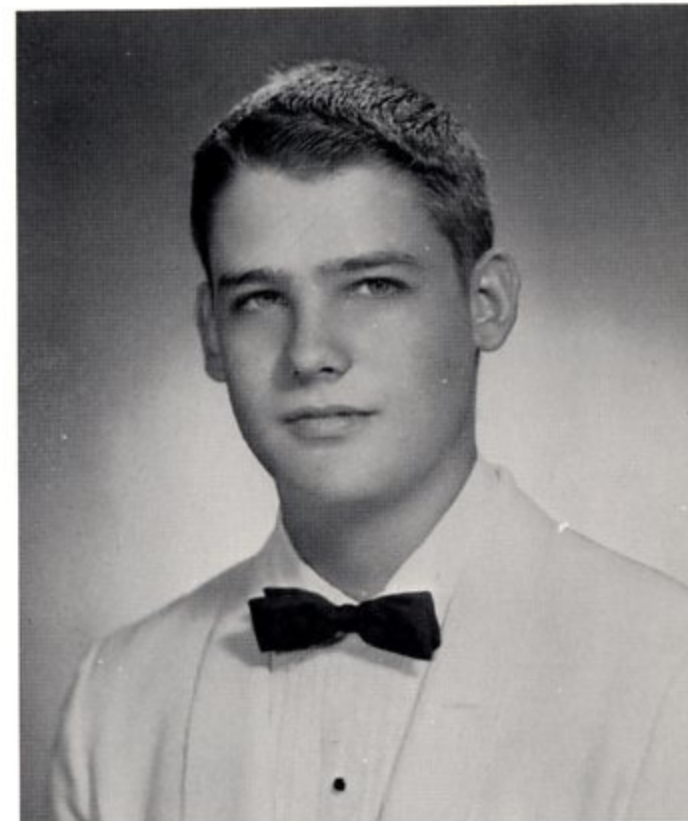
#### ARTURO GUTIERREZ

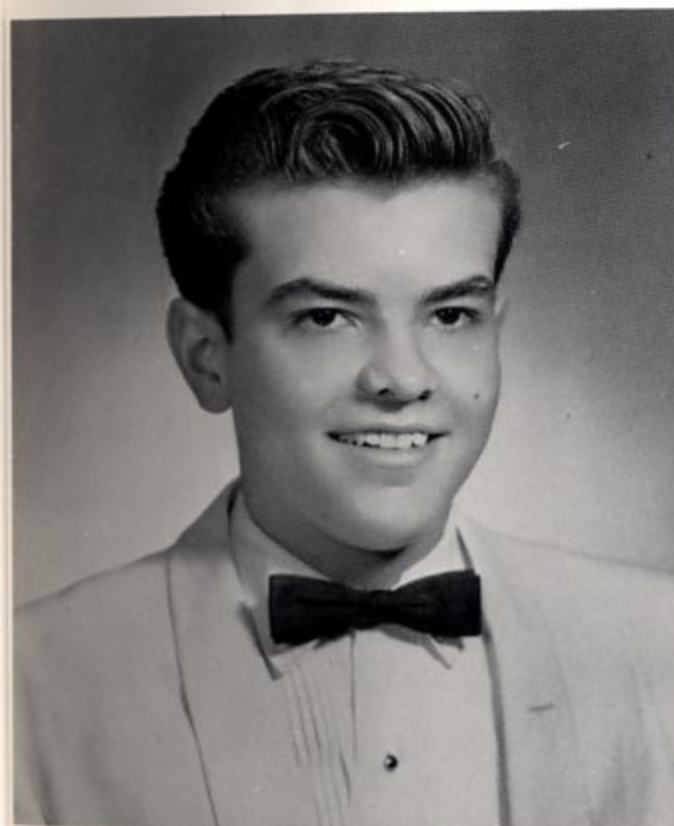
#### WILLIAM BYRON JOHNSON, III

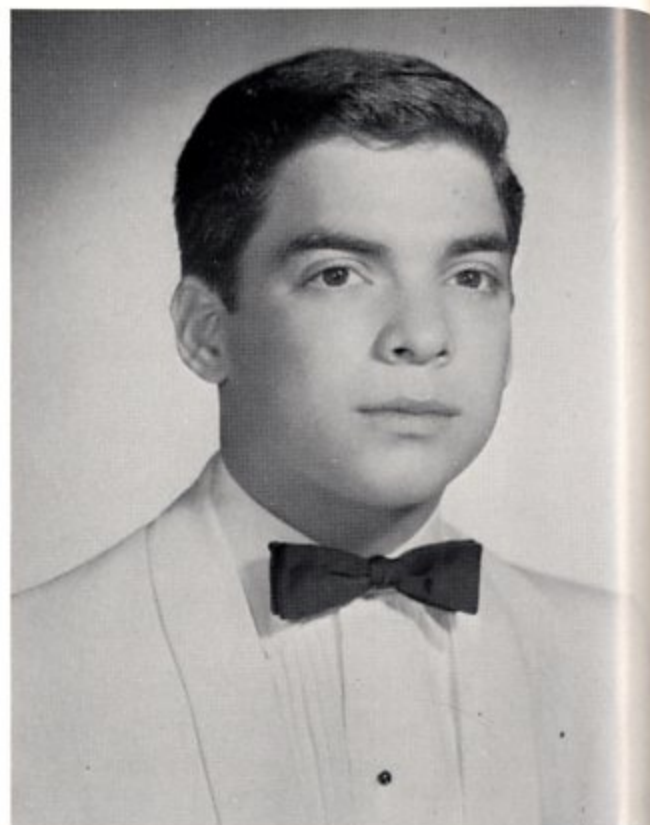
#### PETER E. LAUREL

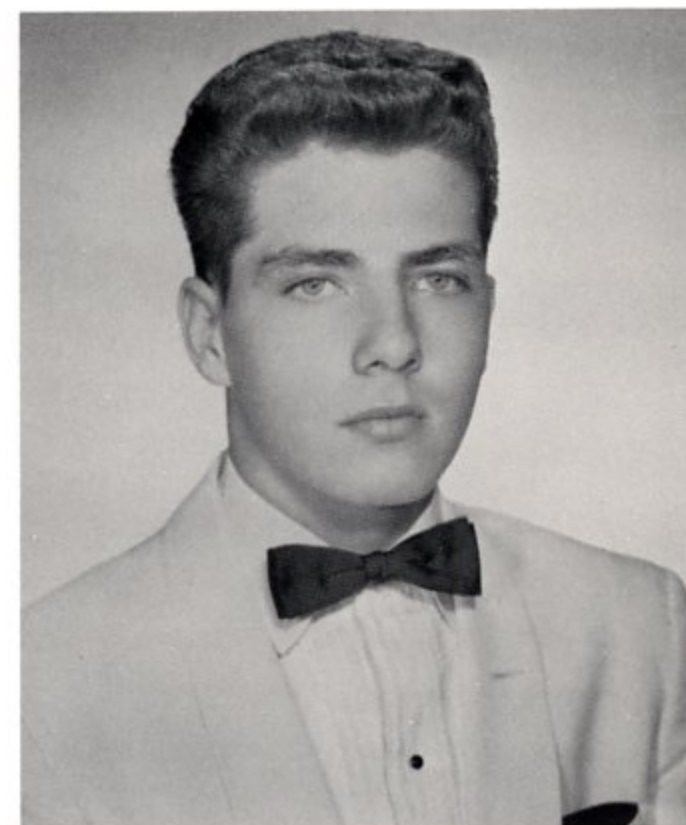
#### RENE P. LAWSON

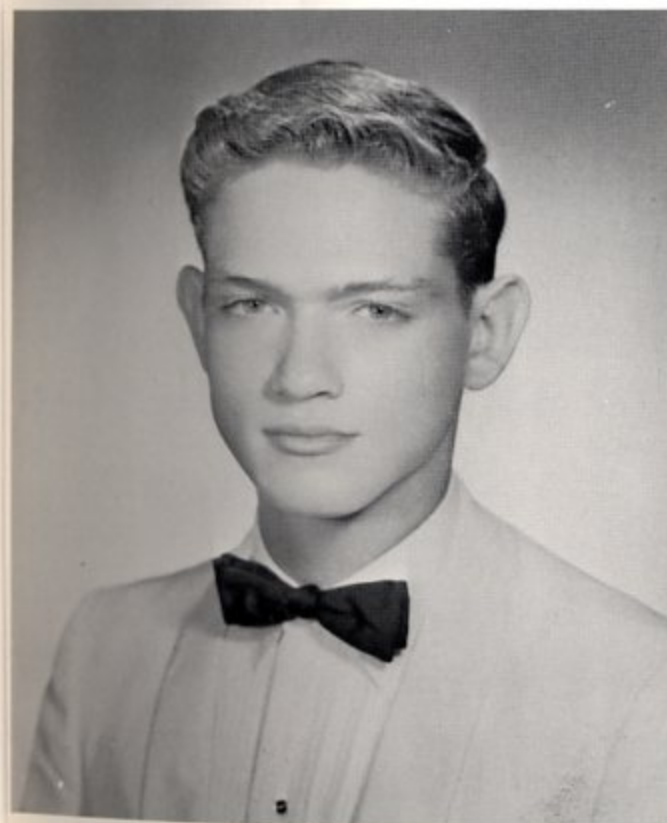
#### MARIO B. MORTERA

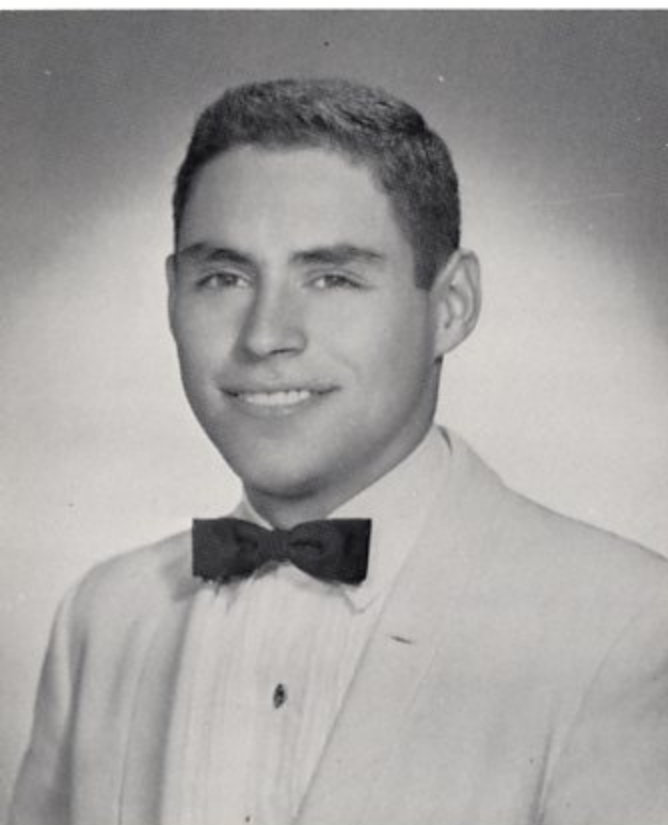
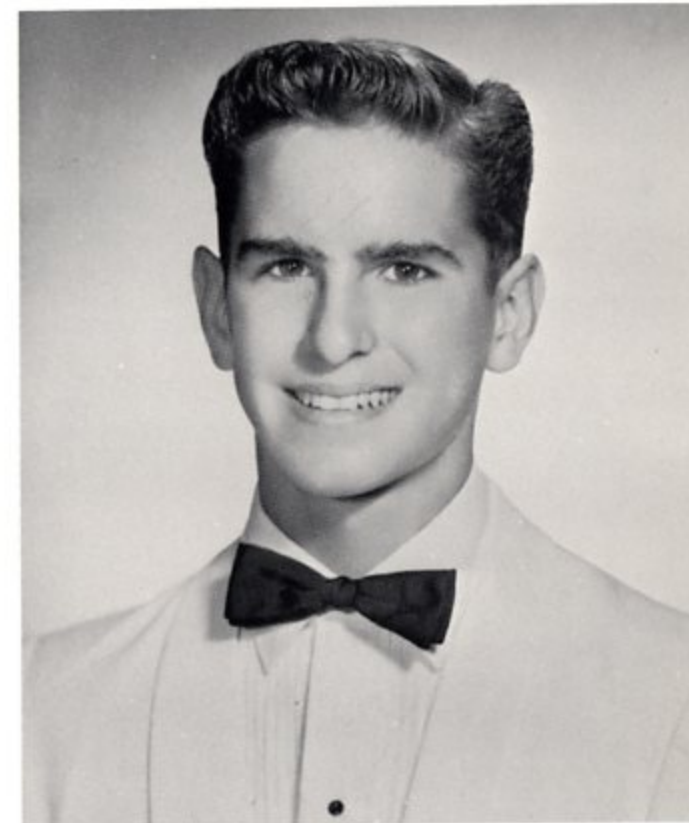
#### ROGELIO QUINTANILLA

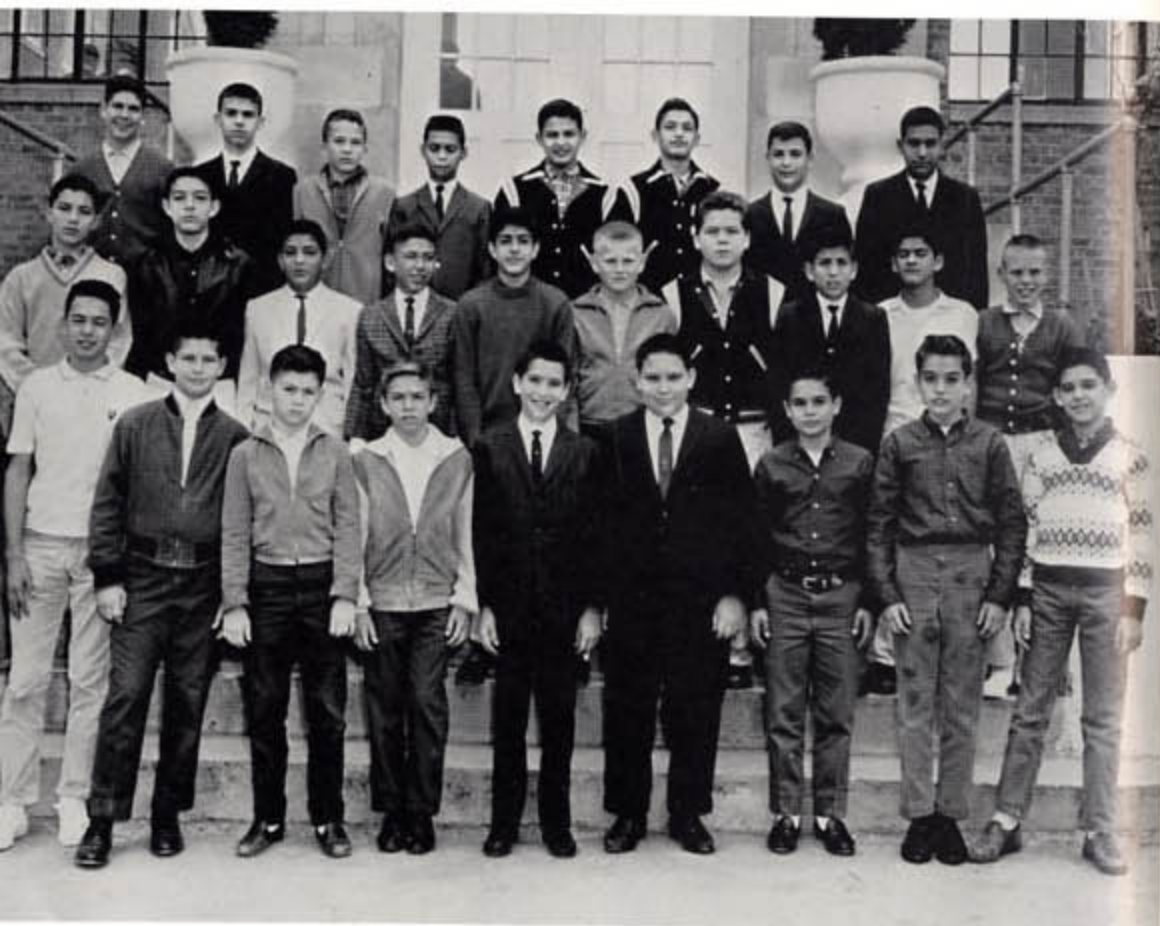
A fact that St. Joseph's is particularly proud is that our school led the All-Student Council, serving as its president.
