
FOREWORD



Such are the students of Martin High School, and it is to these students that we proudly present the 1963 edition of *La Pitahaya*.



After many years of service in the Laredo Public Schools, Mrs. Floy G. Bennett retired in May of 1962.

Mrs. Bennett received her B.A. Degree from Howard Payne and was Head of the History Department.

La Pitahaya awarded Elizabeth Sorrell, Journal sponsor and past sponsor of the yearbook, the dedication because of her outstanding contributions to Martin High School.

During her high school career, the Laredo Journal, which she edited, tied for first place in the state.

She has taught at Martin High School since 1933, and from 1937 until last year, she sponsored the annual. Mrs. Sorrell's teaching career began in 1931 when she spent two years at Christen Junior High School before transferring to high school.

Last summer Mrs. Sorrell was awarded a Wall Street Journalism Fellowship to study under De Witt C. Reddick, head of the Journalism School at the University of Texas.




The bougainvillea blooms frame the home-making cottage which now sports air conditioning.




























