Teachers like Mrs. Watkins are hard to find. For this reason and many others, she is appreciated by Martin High students and faculty members.

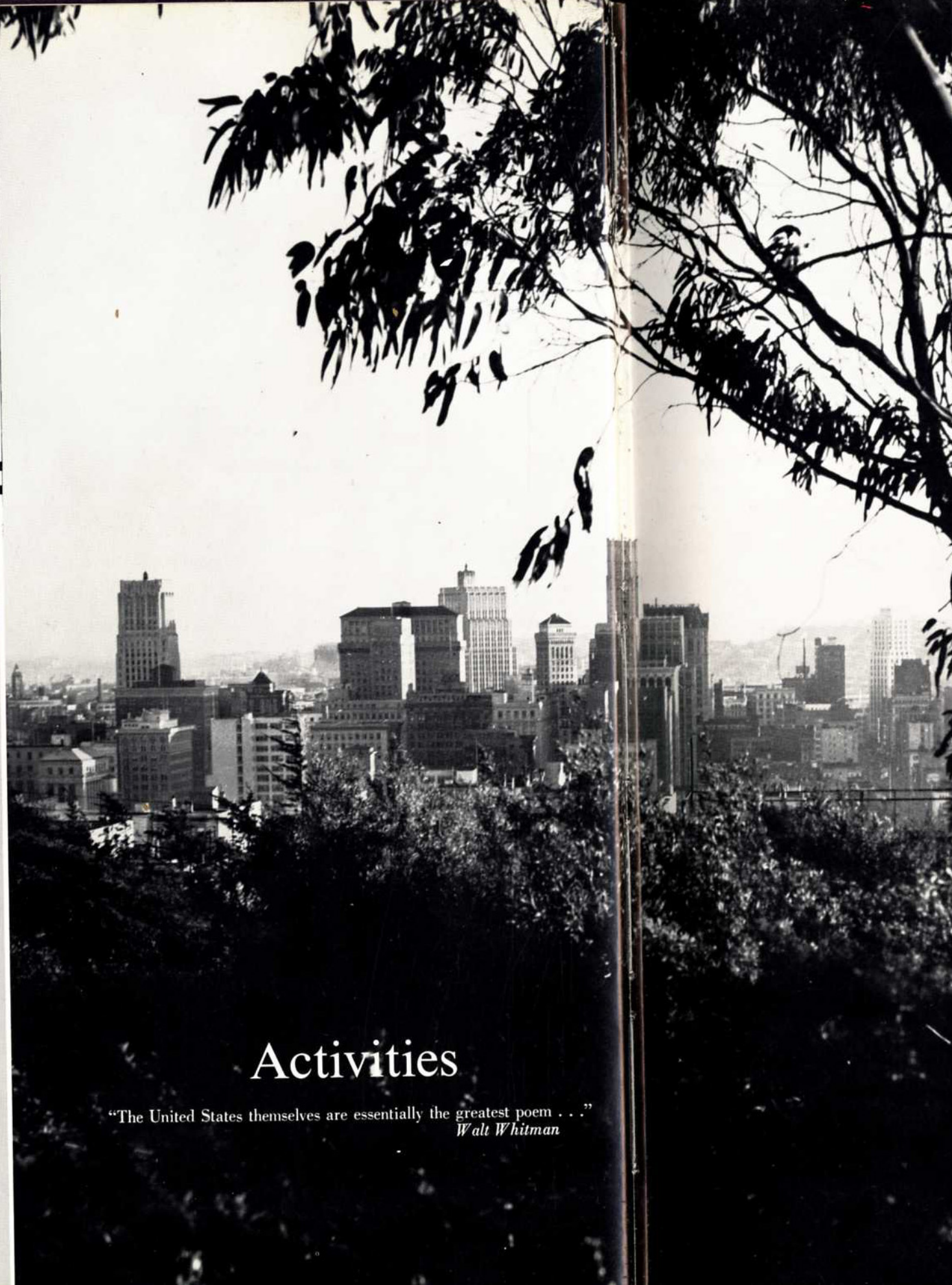

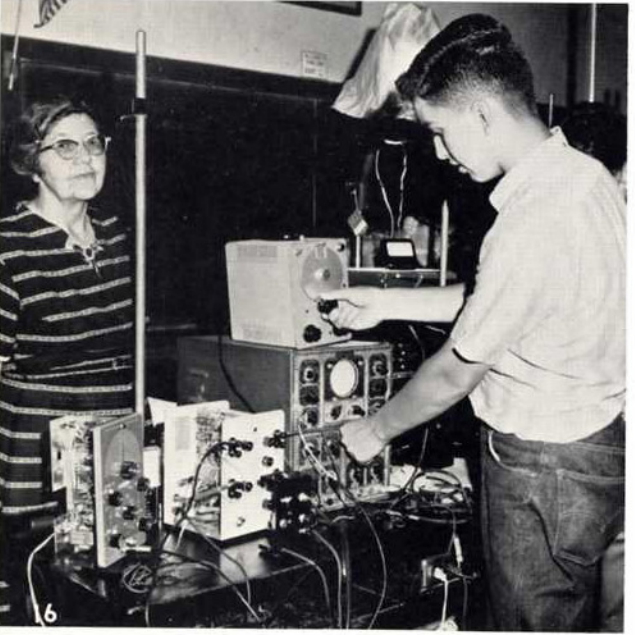

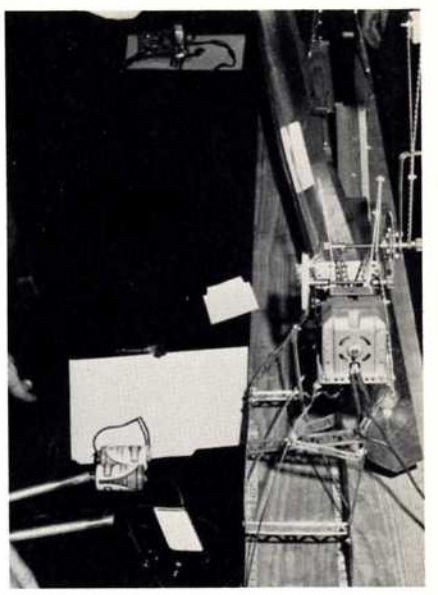

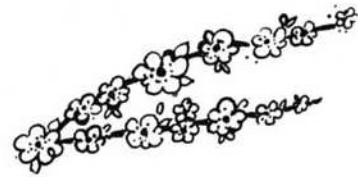

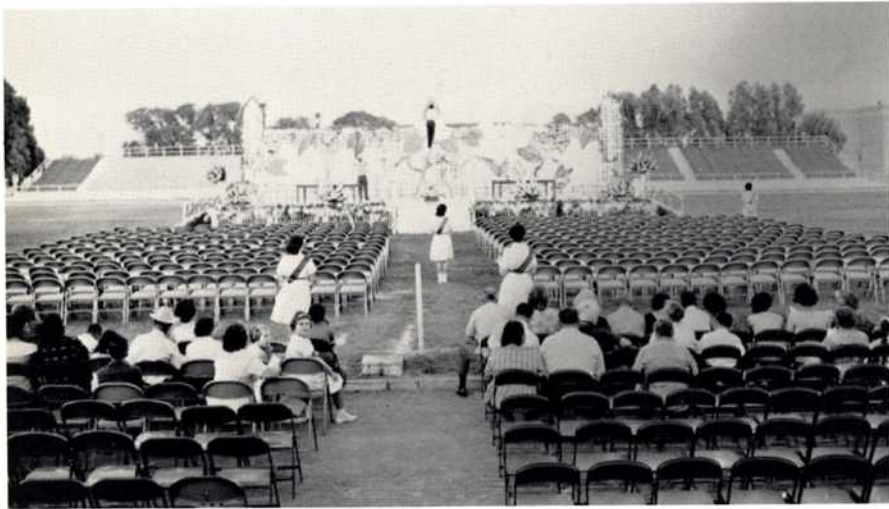

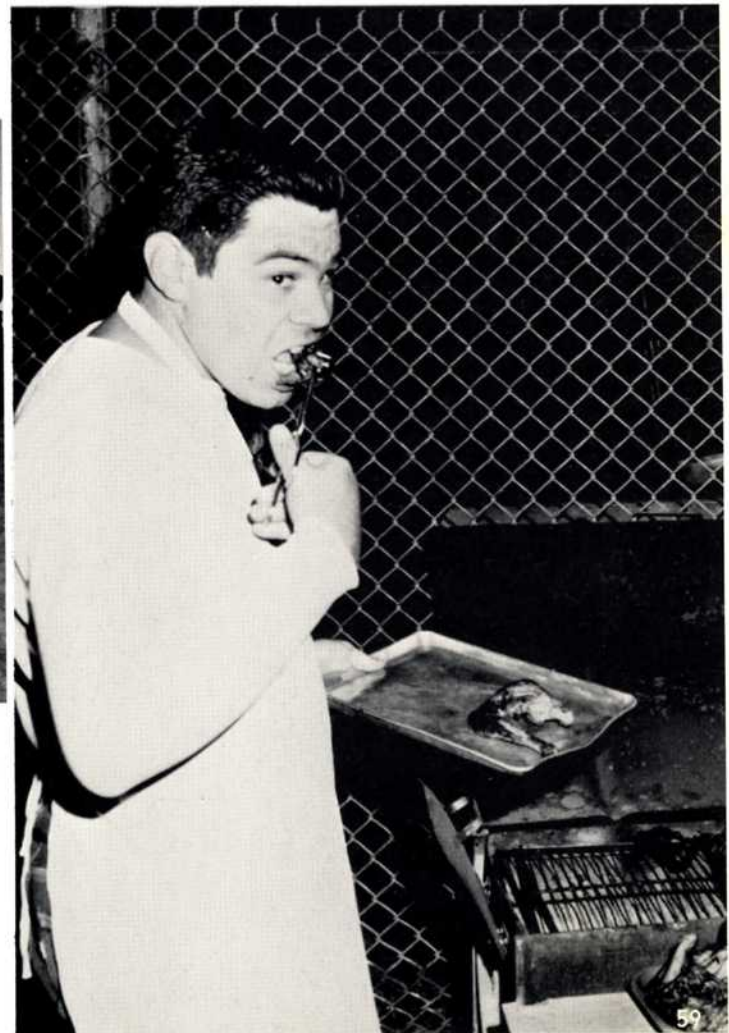

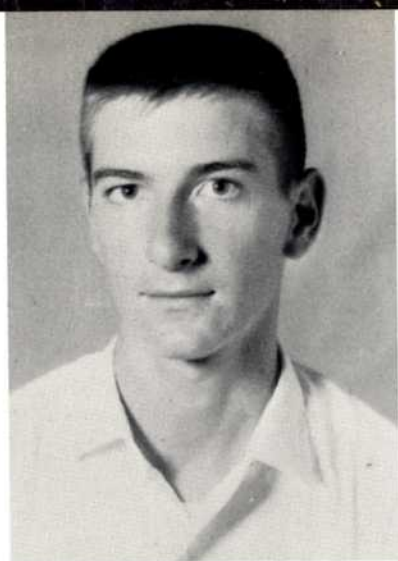

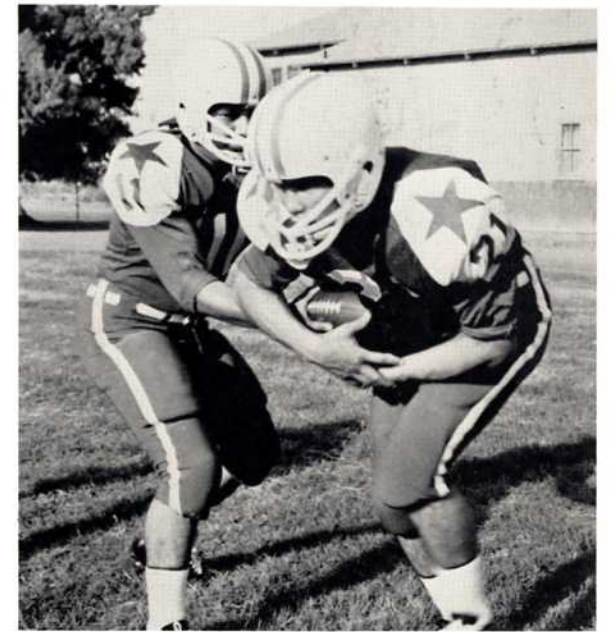

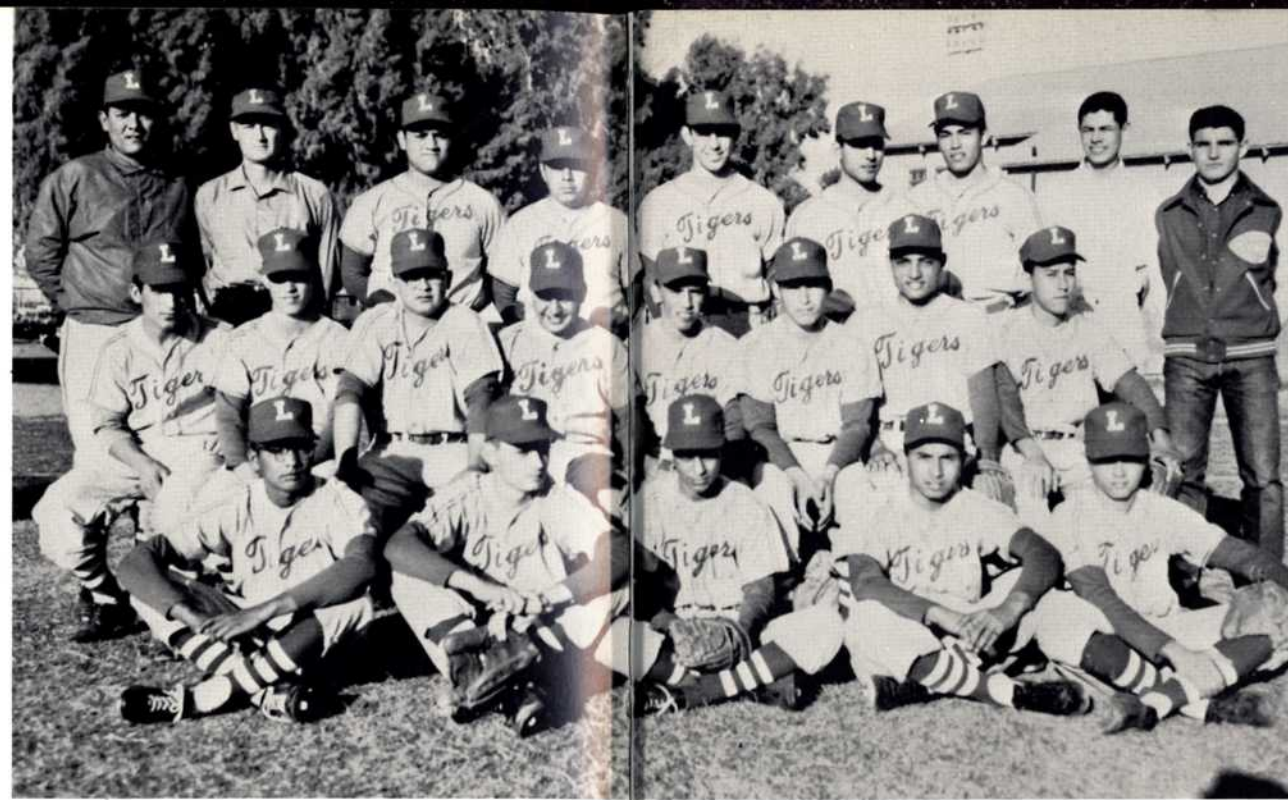

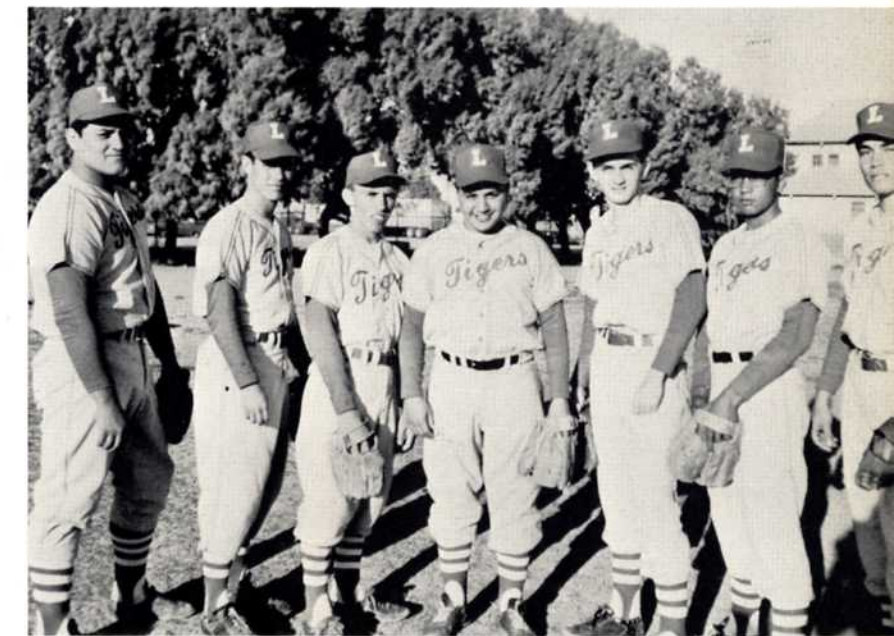

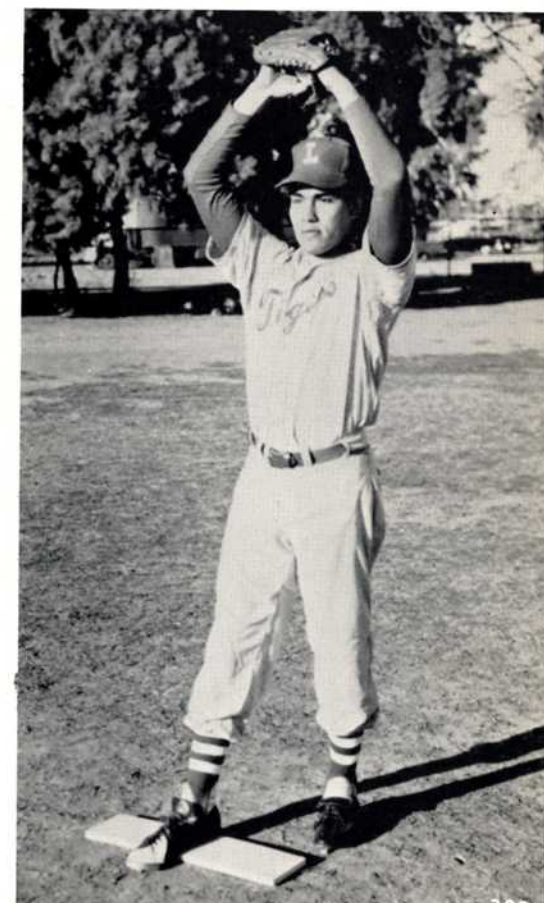
