## Mighty Seniors Remain Active Throughout the Year

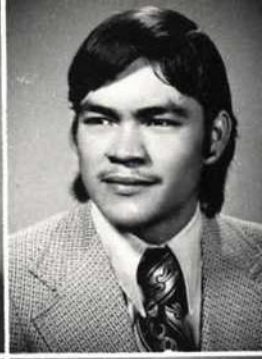

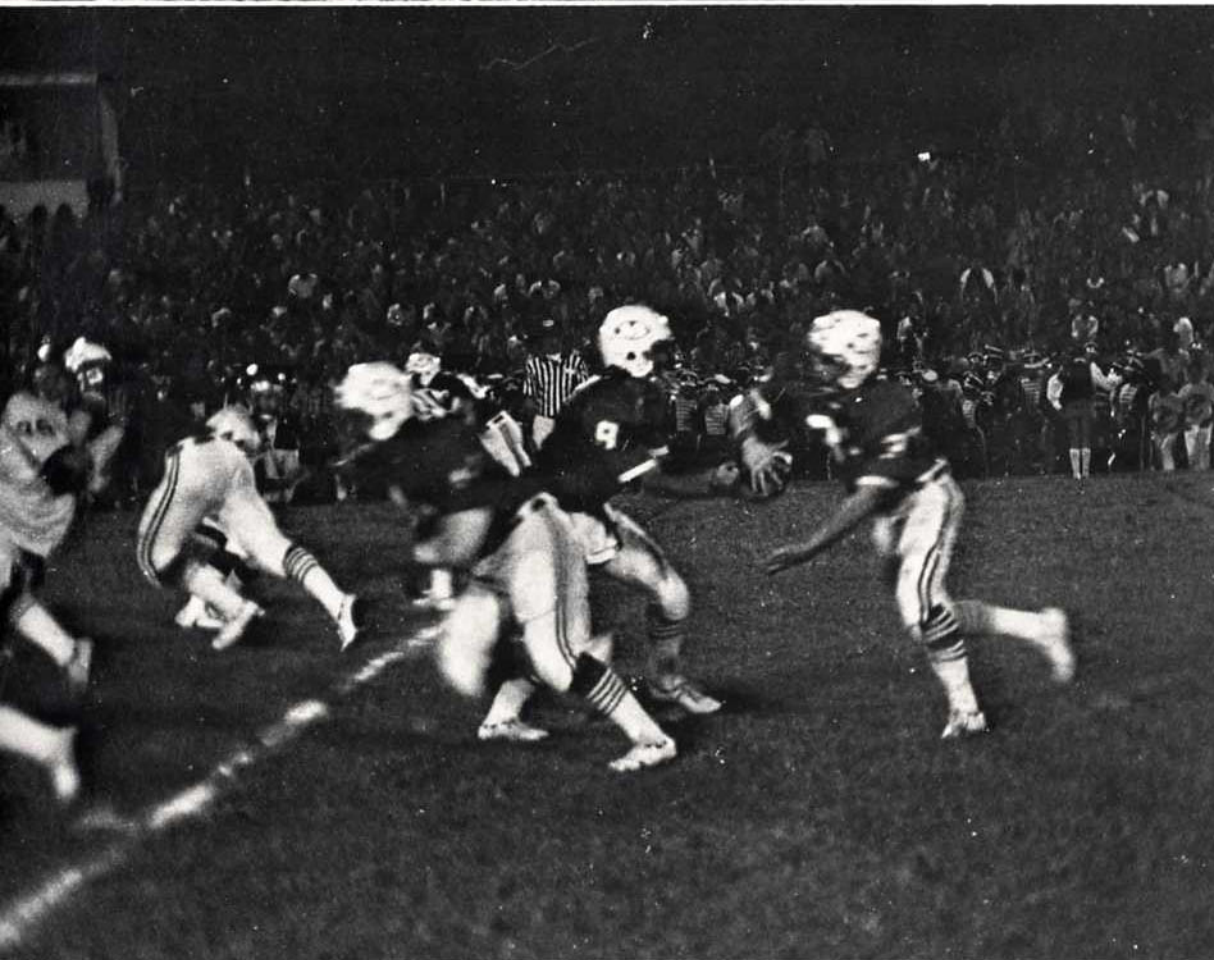

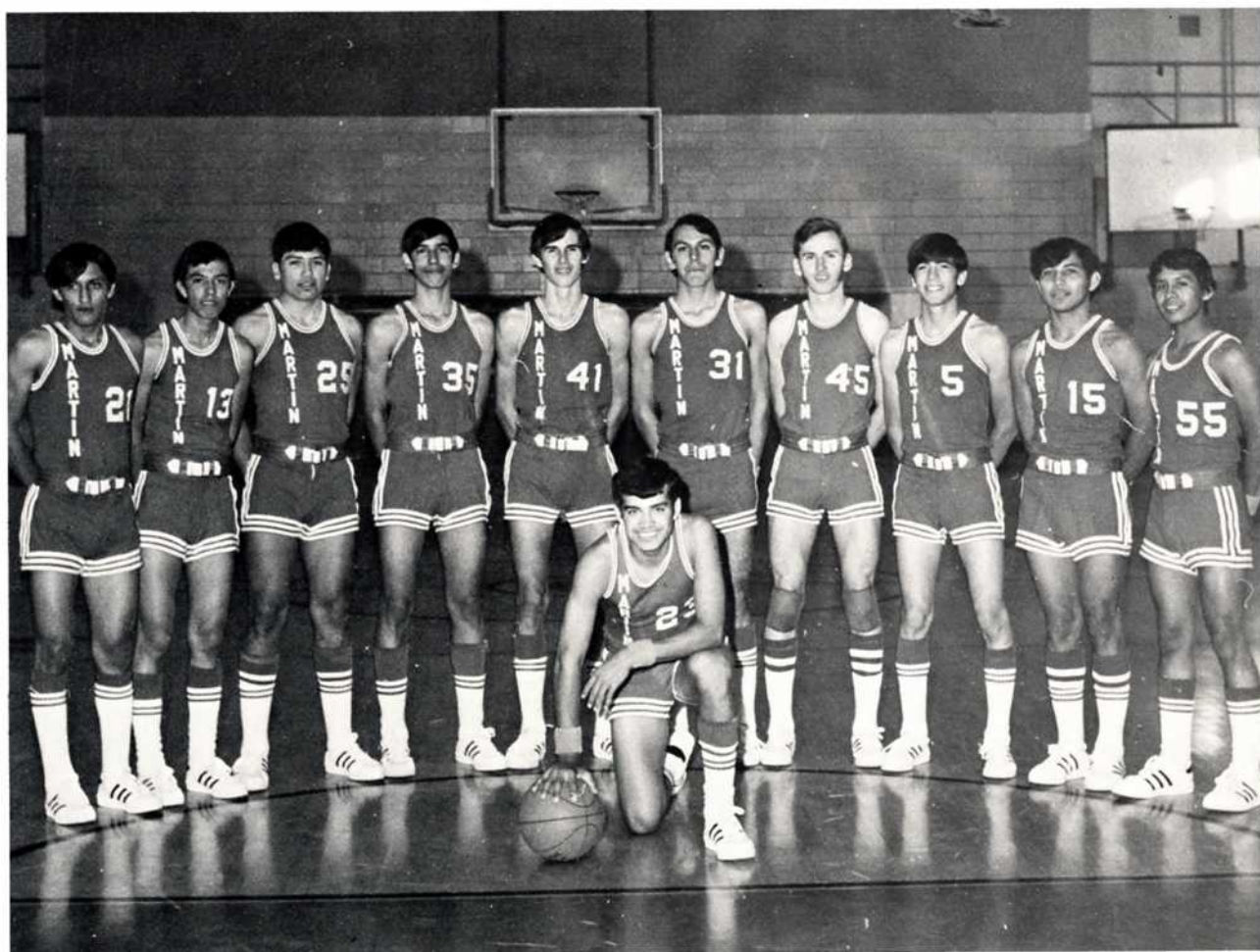
# Basketball Team Has Rough Time

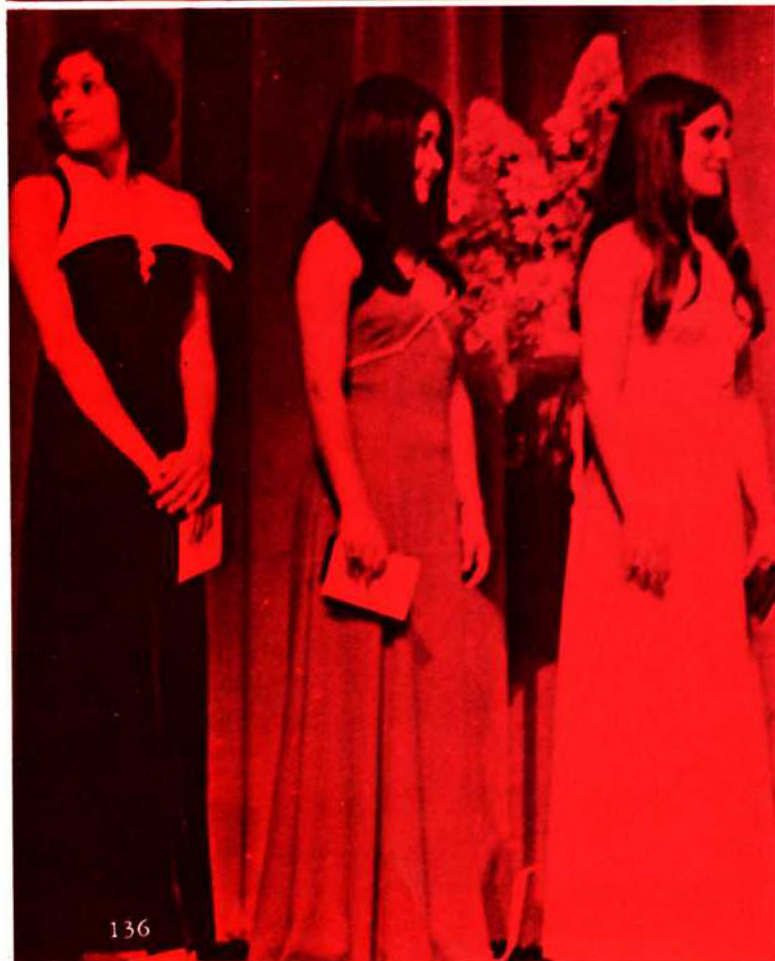

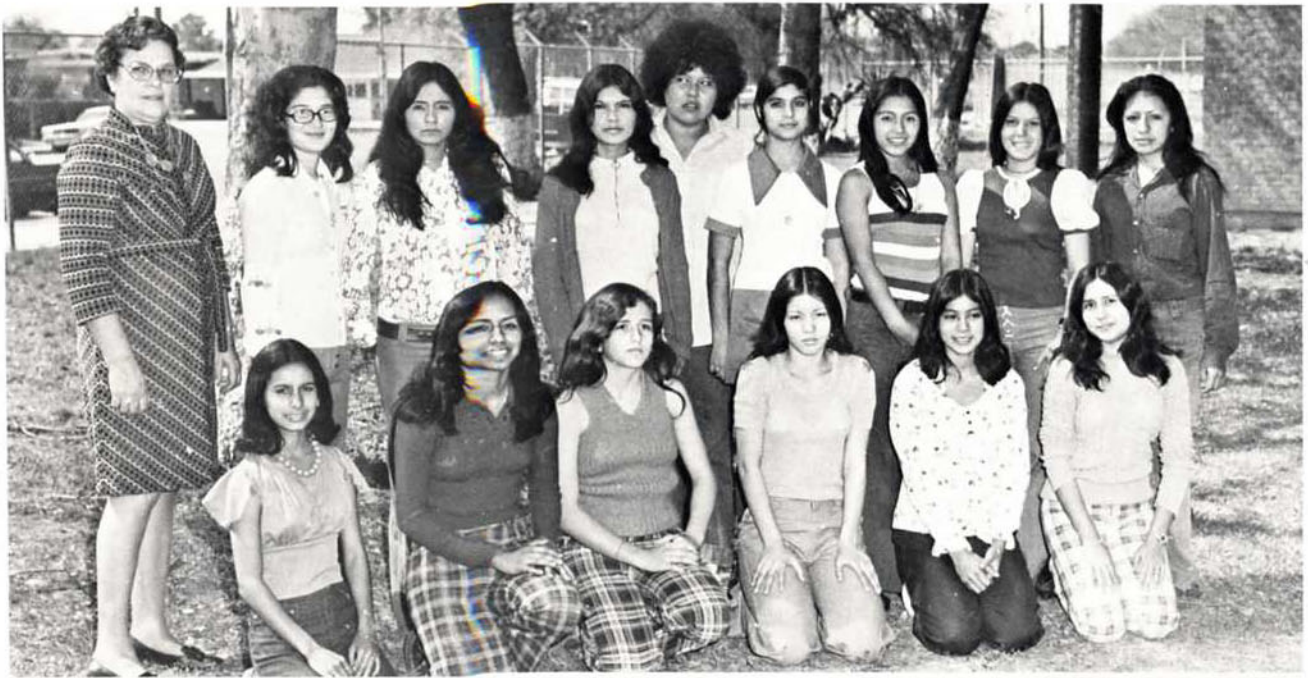

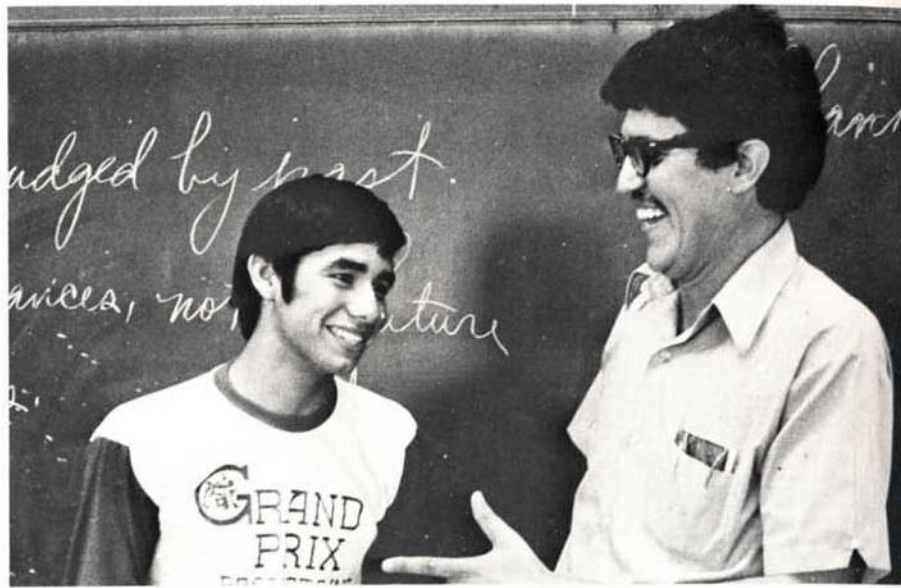

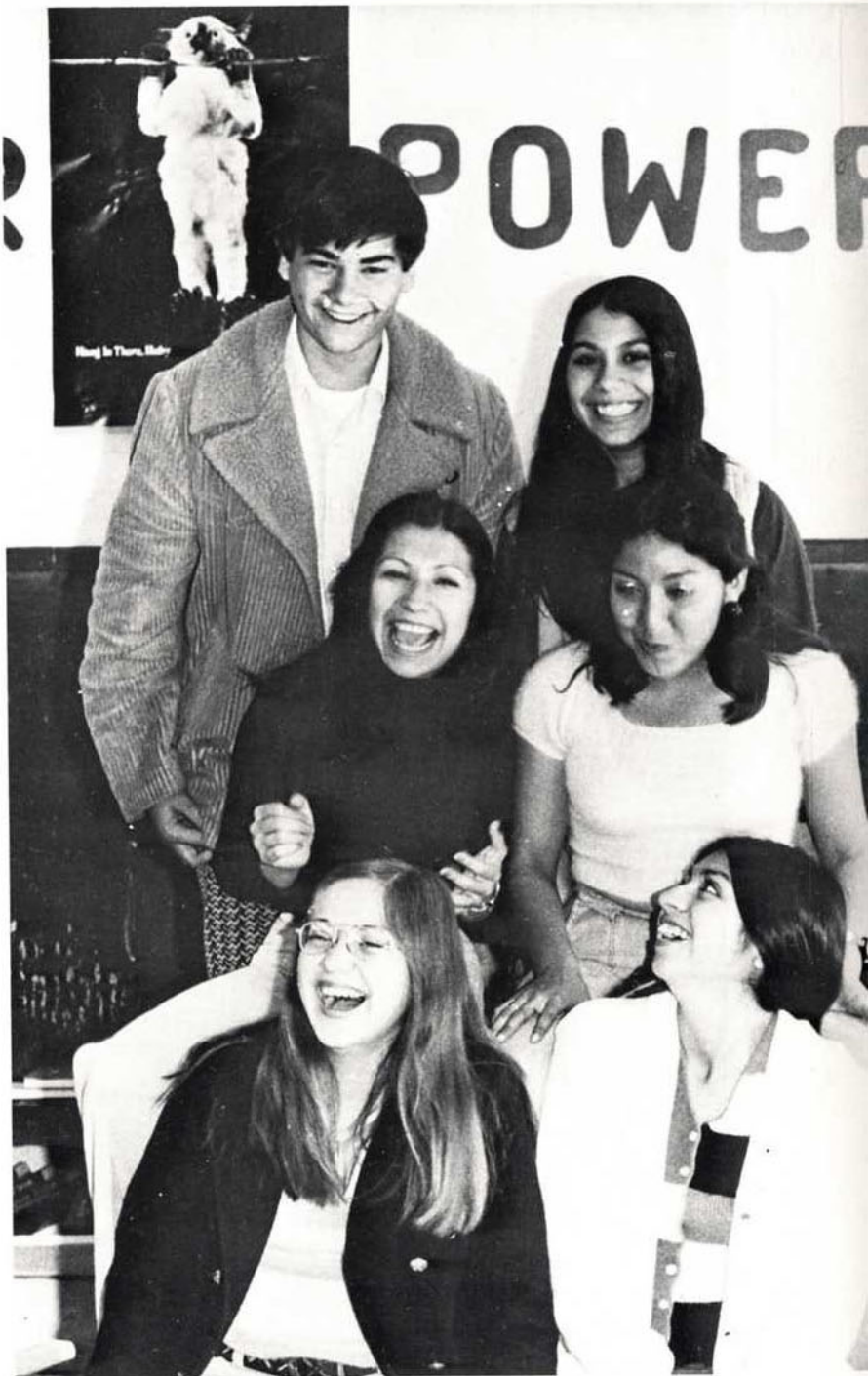

## ROTC PROGRAM MARCHES ON

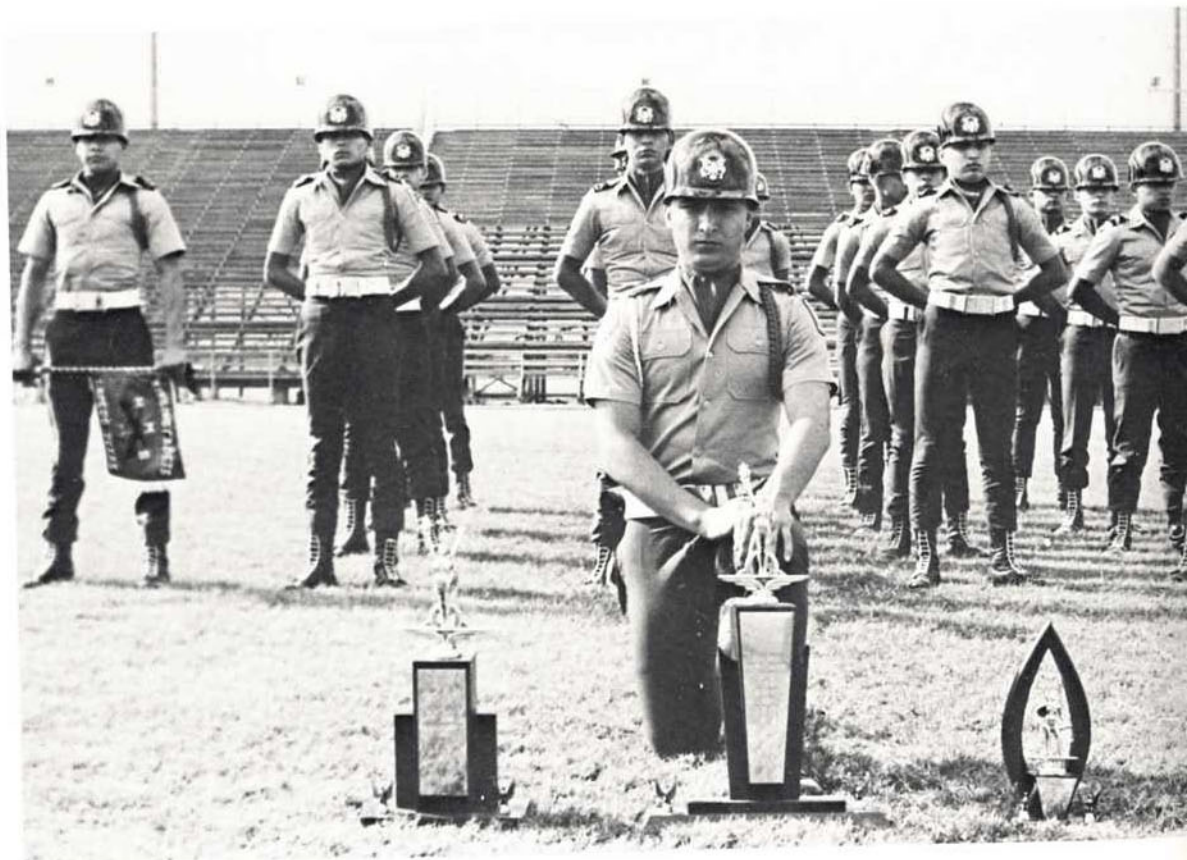

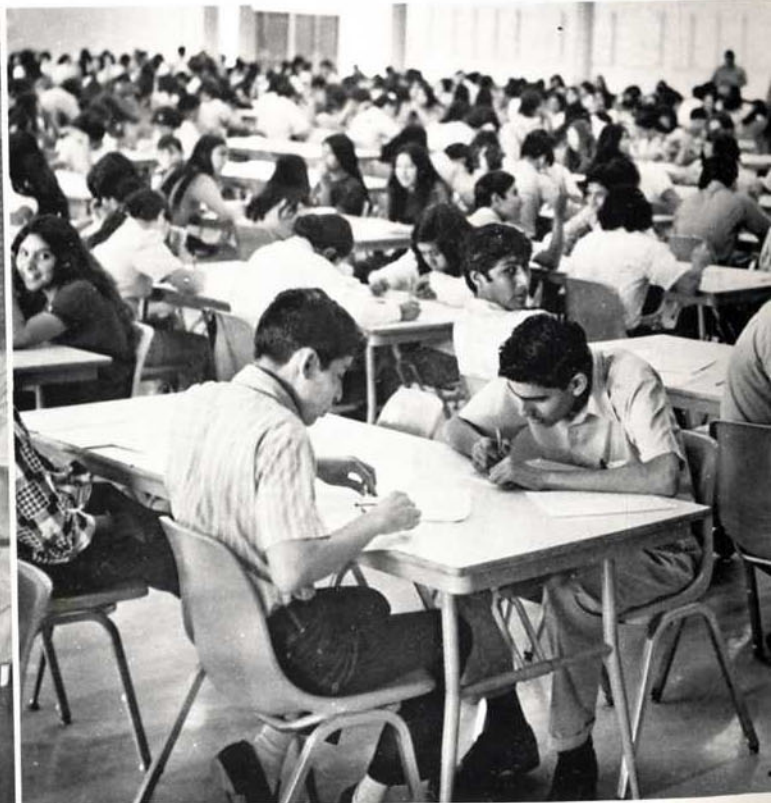
